

Why we need to fundraise

Fundraising is a part of most sporting clubs's lives. At Inswim we have tried to keep this to a minimum where possible. Thank you to everyone who supported the Rotary Raffle, we raised over \$370, out of a possible \$560 that was available from all the tickets that were handed out to families.

Below is the income and expenditure profit and loss sheet that was presented to the AGM in May. This shows where the money comes into the club, and where it is spent. The Carnival entries general under Income is the money families place in the blue box with entry cards for meets run by other clubs on weekends. The Carnival entries is the entries received for the Inswim Meet held in December 2006.

The entry under expenditure titled entry subsidy (\$2,594.15) is the amount returned to families for swimmers who competed at a representative level from Cumberland (district) to National level.

Another activity the club provided a subsidy for was the development camp to Narabeen Fitness Centre. The cost to the club was \$4,505.45, with parents asked to pay a nominal fee of \$70 per swimmer.

We are only able to provide these type of activities for the swimmers with the support of all members of Inswim Swimming Club.
